

AGE & QUALIFICATION

LECTURER: in subjects namely, Organon of Medicine, Homoeopathic Materia Medica, Homoeopathic Pharmacy, Repertory.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION

Post Graduate qualification in Homoeopathy preferably in the concerned subject. The qualification shall be the one included in Second Schedule of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973. Preference shall be given to those candidates who hold experience of working as R.M.O. and/or House Physicians in a Homoeopathic Hospital attached to a Homoeopathic Medical College permitted by Central Council/Central Government.

AGE

Not more than 40 years as on the last date of receipt of application for the post.

LECTURER: in subjects namely, Anatomy, Physiology, Pathology, Forensic Medicine and Toxicology, Surgery, Gynaecology and Obstetrics, Practice of Medicine and Community Medicine.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION

Post Graduate qualification in Homoeopathy. The qualification shall be the one included in Second Schedule of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973. Preference shall be given to those candidates who holds experience of working as R.M.O. and/or House Physicians in a Homoeopathic Hospital attached to a Homoeopathic Medical College permitted by Central Council/Central Government.

OR

Post Graduate Medical Degree in concerned subject recognized by the Medical Council of India. Preference shall be given to those candidates who hold experience of working as R.M.O. and/or House Physicians in a Hospital attached to a Medical College permitted by Medical Council/Central Government.

AGE

Not more than 40 years as on the last date of receipt of application for the post.
